

Since its introduction in October 2015, there has been a significant move towards the adoption of 9.2. <u>It's clear that many users are yet to make the move</u>.








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By changing the release schedule and extending support for 9.2 by at least another seven years, Oracle has established the longest published support timeline of any major ERP software vendor.










JD Edwards EnterpriseOne 9.2 is a game changer for JD Edwards as it is built from the ground up with the digital enterprise in mind. Since being released, 9.2 has delivered a wide range of enhancements.







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The digital enterprise is one that embraces the pervasive use of digital technologies and more than that, it is a fundamental change in business process and policy - a change in what we do and how we do it.









If we accept that organizations need to change what they do and how they do it, we must consider the <u>challenges that need</u> to be <u>overcome</u> as they strive to do things differently.








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- 1. Prepare by thoroughly analyzing the business and technical impact of every ESU.

### B&G opportunities to save/improve



- Preparation
  - Simultaneously look at the business/testing and code/retrofitting impacts
  - Dimension Focus
    - Project Dashboard, Heatmap, Linker
  - Dimension Tempo
    - ► Health Check, Impact Report
- Execution
  - Invest in script writing to automate testing
  - Leverage scripts to ease the burden of testing
  - Unit and system test before involving their users







## Pharmavite adopted their code-current strategy to:

- Replace big upgrade projects with smaller codecurrent events.
- Improve the quality and speed of projects by automating testing
- Outsource technical retrofitting to free up internal development resources









As a result, Pharmavite has started budgeting annual OPEX projects and contracted with DWS for our entire portfolio products and services. Their stated goal is to <a href="mailto:ensure that IT and E1">ensure that IT and E1</a> are more attuned and responsive to their business.




